OVERALL DEVELOPMENTAL APPROACH

Welcome to Tidy Towns 2000. Thank you for your village development plan and maps. It is nice to see that you have the support of all the local residents and that your committee is made up jointly of adult and junior members.

THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT

Cruachan Ai is a credit to everyone involved. The disabled facilities were noted and the tree planting and flower boxes look good. It is nice to see that the new owner of the Mart area has started to clean it up. The new housing development looks good but one of the gardens is overgrown. The new ball alley, when finished, will be a great asset.

LANDSCAPING

There is a great effort being put into the provision of flower beds, hanging baskets and flower boxes. The flower beds along the G.A.A. grounds were full of weeds. The grass in the graveyard had been recently cut but not gathered up.

WILDLIFE AND NATURAL AMENITIES

There appeared to be some work in progress along the river bank. This is an area which should be developed further. Perhaps an information board near the bridge highlighting the wildlife in the area would be informative for visitors.

LITTER CONTROL

The refuse bins had been left out for collection neatly. There were two black sacks of litter ripped open in the G.A.A. car park and also some litter beside the gate and near the phone box in the village.

TIDINESS

Moylan's Shop looks well but the garden wall needs to be painted. Kelly's Bar sign on the Ballaghadereen Road and their car park sign need to be painted also. Noone's Foodstore might consider a new sign. Some of the grass verges were overgrown and there is an unsightly builder's yard which needs to be screened off too.

RESIDENTIAL AREAS

The house across the road from the Ballintubber junction had very nice hanging baskets and flower boxes. There is

still some room for improvement in this area yet.

ROADS, STREETS AND BACK AREAS

The car park needs to be re-surfaced. Watch out for weeds along walls and kerbsides and around the edges of the Church car park. The beer barrels and crates were a bit untidy at the side of the Tulska Inn. Convoy's butcher shop looks well.

GENERAL IMPRESSION

Tulsk has great potential. Keep up the pressure to get the Mart area and the G.A.A. area cleaned up. Keep up the good work.
