### **OVERALL DEVELOPMENTAL APPROACH**

Thanks for your submission, which included a map of the village and a village heritage brochure. The submission should include a brief five-year plan and a schedule of completed works. The Committee is a large and successful group who have actively co-operated with local community and business interest groups and with the local authority.

### **THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT**

Moynalty is a classic picturesque estate village with a range of public and private type buildings arranged along a central axial street. The buildings are without exception well maintained and presented.

### **LANDSCAPING**

The landscaping in and around the village is outstanding with beautifully landscaped open areas. In addition, there are a range of hard and soft landscape features evenly distributed around the village.

### **WILDLIFE AND NATURAL AMENITIES**

The river walk and amenity area are well maintained and offer extensive opportunity to experience wildlife and the natural environment around the village.

### **LITTER CONTROL**

The village and the approach roads were totally clear of litter on the day of the inspection.

### **TIDINESS**

The village is extremely neat and tidy. All around the village the street furniture is in perfect order.

### **RESIDENTIAL AREAS**

The housing in and around the village is intrinsically good and attractively presented.

### **ROADS, STREETS AND BACK AREAS**

The approach roads into the village are splendidly managed and consist of a range of trim margins, hedges, trees and stone walling. In addition, the village signs are attractive and well maintained.

### **GENERAL IMPRESSION**

Great attention has been given to maintaining and presenting the richness of this village.

It is a delightful place to visit and clearly reflects the hard work of the committee and the inhabitants.

## **SECOND ADJUDICATION (03/08/01)**

Moynalty in all its aspects was looking exceptionally smart at midsummer – a credit to those who have worked so hard throughout the year.
