### **OVERALL DEVELOPMENTAL APPROACH**

Welcome to Tidy Towns 2001, and thank you for your completed entry form. Your village area is quite spread out, in order to draw all projects, ideas and areas together a 3-5 year plan is a must.

### **THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT**

The Church and grounds which appear to be the focal point in your village look well. The Grotto is especially nice and the Bog Oak adds interest. The Community Centre is freshly painted, and some clearing has taken place around same. However there are a number of buildings which require painting – the Dispensary, Creatons pub, walls and piers at cemetery.

### **LANDSCAPING**

The road widening and construction of nice stone walls has greatly enhanced your village. The landscaping from School to Church is particularly nice. The trees on the Loughglynn approach road are maturing and the shrubbery at the cross-road is nice, however this area requires tidying up. The flowerbeds at turning to Children's burial ground are nice, but grass in this area requires cutting.

### **WILDLIFE AND NATURAL AMENITIES**

I note your proposal to clean up area around bog, develop a nature walk, and identify wildlife in area. This is probably a project you could get School involved in.

### **LITTER CONTROL**

There was litter evidence of litter on my visit.

### **TIDINESS**

An effort is being made in this area, however there is room for improvement.

### **RESIDENTIAL AREAS**

Most of the residents have very well maintained houses and gardens. There are a number of new houses in area and when complete will look well, ensure all builders rubble etc. is cleared.

### **ROADS, STREETS AND BACK AREAS**

The road widening on the Ballyhaunis approach will look well when finished. Grass verges on all approach roads requires cutting.

### **GENERAL IMPRESSION**

The village of Lisacul is quite spread out. The crossroads

at the Church appear to be the focal point, and with the area from here to the School now landscaped, this whole area is looking very well. Keep up the good work.
