OVERALL DEVELOPMENTAL APPROACH

Welcome to the Tidy Towns Competition of 2002 and thank you for your application. Moone is a very pleasant well cared for village and has forwarded a very good presentation.

THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT

Most residencies are presented to the highest standard. The post office looks well as does the school. The pillars at the road to the high cross are an interesting feature. The Church looked excellent on the day of adjudication. The ball alley could be planted with climbers as it detracts from the general impression. Some work appears to be underway on the wall at the river - well done on this project.

LANDSCAPING

Gardens have been well presented and planting is evident on the Timolin Road. Tubs and flowers are noted. However permanent planting is always better. The area across from the school is a possible area for planting shrubs and flowers. Green areas on approach roads were well maintained. The trees outside Shackleton village will be a lovely feature.

WILDLIFE AND NATURAL AMENITIES

The committee under this heading has forwarded no plans. Identification of projects or areas is important and should be sought out for next year.

LITTER CONTROL

On the day of adjudication litter control was very good. Some litter was noted near the phone box. Details of your litter activities should be included with you application.

TIDINESS

Moone does well under this heading. Keep an eye on weeds and grass verges.

RESIDENTIAL AREAS

The houses in Moone are well maintained and presented. Shackleton Village looks extremely well even though the unoccupied house on the left after the entrance detracts from the overall impression.

ROADS, STREETS AND BACK AREAS

Most areas are in good order. Some road signs need to be replaced or cleaned.

GENERAL IMPRESSION

The overall impression of Moone is very favourable. A simple

plan would have been helpful to the adjudicator in order to see what the Tidy Towns Committee wishes to achieve in the future.
