### **OVERALL DEVELOPMENTAL APPROACH**

Welcome to Tidy Towns 2002, and thank you for your completed entry form. I note that you are a committee of four but I would concur with previous adjudicators to draw up a work plan. Set out some realistic objectives that you can work to. A lot of new development is taking place in your village with new house developments – maybe you can encourage some new residents to become involved and share the workload.

### **THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT**

The School looks particularly well and a credit to all involved. The derelict house adjacent still stands out for all the wrong reasons. The forecourt is being developed but will greatly enhance this area... The machinery yard and the sewerage works are the two areas which detract from the overall visual impact. As the sewerage scheme is now complete, continue to liaise with the council to have this area sorted. The football pitch/ car park is a new development, it will be nice to see area completed and landscaped as it will enhance the approach from that side of village. I notice a new sign has been erected at the Mill Bar however the plough at base, is still in need of painting.

### **LANDSCAPING**

As mentioned in previous report , the entrance to the Monksland sewerage scheme is needs to be tidied up as it detracts from the overall visual impact on this approach. Weeding is required on bed in green outside school, and on Athlone Rd approach. The tubs at The Mill Bar Car-park still need attention. The landscaping as you approach the Woodview Golf Club is particularly nice.

### **WILDLIFE AND NATURAL AMENITIES**

The River is the natural amenity which could be developed under this section. Also talk to the teachers in the school they maybe interested in getting involved in the green school programme.

### **LITTER CONTROL**

Litter control in general was very good. Keep up the good work.

### **TIDINESS**

There is an overall impression of tidiness in the village apart from the two areas already mentioned (machinery yard and sewerage scheme)

## **RESIDENTIAL AREAS**

Residential areas are well kept and maintained.

## **ROADS, STREETS AND BACK AREAS**

You have much new development taking place, so much building rubble etc. in view. I look forward to seeing road to new housing estate at back of Mill completed. The stone wall along here looks well.
