OVERALL DEVELOPMENTAL APPROACH

Thank you for your completed entry form together with maps. It was helpful on adjudication day. Well done for all of the work you have carried out to-date. You have a very small committee, perhaps you could encourage more of the community to become involved. You certainly have the right attitude and would appear to be very focused in that you are firstly making Tulsk a lovely place to live and secondly, a lovely place for visitors to visit.

THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT

Once again the Cruachan Ai Visitor centre is presented to a good standard. It is good to have a visitor centre of this calibre in the village and I am sure that it attracts many visitors to this area.

The Church grounds and the graveyard are well presented, but perhaps a fresh coat of paint at the boundary walls of the church and school is needed. The business premises are well maintained. The GAA grounds and surrounding area are a credit to all concerned.

LANDSCAPING

The landscaping at the Church and the visitor centre is very nice. Also the individual flower boxes. The picnic table at the car park area is an added asset, perhaps if money allows one or two more could be provided.

WILDLIFE AND NATURAL AMENITIES

Good idea to provide a story board identifying the wildlife and natural habitat in the area. I always suggest that it would be good to involve the school children here.

LITTER CONTROL

Litter control is very good. The area where the recycling bins are placed is kept neat and tidy, it is all too often that this is not the case and you are to be commended for this. There was some evidence of litter on the Athlone approach road. Everybody must play their part in the control of litter.

TIDINESS

The grass verges and kerbsides are well attended to. Your litter awareness clean up day was a very good idea and it obviously paid off. Well done.

RESIDENTIAL AREAS

The private houses are presented to a good standard. I saw

some lovely gardens. Most people taking pride in their own homes. A good individual effort being made under this category.
