Overall Developmental Approach:

Welcome back to the Tidy Towns Competition and thank you for the entry form. I would recommend you draw up a simple 3 year Development Plan setting out clear objectives which can be achieved each year.

The Built Environment:

The Church and grounds were very well maintained. The sports field with Children's play area and picnic tables looked well. The cart of the street is a nice feature and the seating along the Kilkerrin Rd. looked well. Capping on school wall needs repainting.

Landscaping:

Flower beds and tree planting along main road are very effective. The grounds and planting in the Church are maintained to a high standard. There were a number of nicely landscaped gardens in private houses with a good variety of trees.

Wildlife and Natural Amenities:

There is no mention of Wildlife in your entry form. The involvement of school children in a project would help the children to be more aware of the importance of protecting the Wildlife and Natural amenities in their locality.

Litter Control:

Litter control is good. Litter bins and ashtrays/bins outside all business premises will help control litter.

Tidiness:

The derelict house opposite Coppinger's is conspicuous, considering its central location. The Pub beside it could do with painting, also the building opposite, Londis needs attention.

Residential Areas:

New houses at Old Meadow look well with nice green area. The houses on the Newbridge Road and the houses behind the Church are very well maintained with nice gardens and trees. Railings on house beside Service Station needs painting.

Roads, Streets and Back Areas:

Approach roads good with well trimmed verges. One area needing attention is the road opposite the sports field. High overgrowth at entrance to fields and behind stone walls should be kept in check. Good footpaths along housing area in Meadow Court.

General Impression:

Endeavour to enlist the wider community of Moylough in your Tidy Town plans, your hard work is starting to bear fruit. Keep up the good work and good luck in the future.
